LOCATION.--Lat 35°23'14", long 79°49'53" referenced to North American Datum of 1983, Montgomery County, NC, Hydrologic Unit 03040104, on left bank, 9 ft downstream from bridge on Secondary Road 1340, 50 ft upstream from Black Rock Branch, 0.2 mi upstream from Norfolk Southern Railway bridge, 0.3 mi downstream from West Fork Little River, and 3 mi west of Star.

DRAINAGE AREA.--106 mi².

SURFACE-WATER RECORDS

PERIOD OF RECORD.--April 1954 to current year. Occasional low-flow measurements, water years 1949-54.

REVISED RECORDS.--WDR NC-80-1: Drainage area.

GAGE.--Water-stage recorder and crest-stage gage. Datum of gage is 409.00 ft above National Geodetic Vertical Datum of 1929. Satellite telemetry at station.

REMARKS.--No estimated daily discharges. Records good. No flow also occurred August 13-15, 25-26, 2002. Minimum discharge for current water year also occurred October 21-23.

EXTREMES OUTSIDE PERIOD OF RECORD.--Flood in September 1945 reached a stage of about 20 ft, from information by local resident.
