LOCATION.--Lat 34°48'36.8", long 76°40'17.0" referenced to North American Datum of 1983, Carteret County, NC, Hydrologic Unit 03020106, on Secondary Road 1163, .17 mi east of North Carolina Highway 101, 7 mi north of Beaufort.

GROUNDWATER RECORDS

WELL CHARACTERISTICS.--Depth 19 ft. Upper casing diameter 2.0 in; top of first opening 9 ft, bottom of last opening 14 ft.

DATUM.--Land-surface datum is 7.50 ft above National Geodetic Vertical Datum of 1929. Measuring point: Top of casing, 3.30 ft above land-surface datum, March 2, 2002, to present.

PERIOD OF RECORD.--April 2002, April 2005, April 2007 to current year.

GAGE.--Measured periodically with steel and electric tape.

REMARKS.--Well is measured as part of the National Water Quality Assessment (NAWQA) program.

EXTREMES FOR PERIOD OF RECORD.--Highest water level measured, 2.18 ft below land-surface datum, April 1, 2002; lowest water level measured, 4.29 ft below land-surface datum, June 26, 2008.
