LOCATION.--Lat 41°26'34", long 80°35'18" referenced to North American Datum of 1927, Trumbull County, OH, Hydrologic Unit 05030102, on the right bank at downstream side of bridge on St. Rt. 7, at Kinsman, 0.8 mi downstream from Sugar Creek and 1.2 mi upstream from Stratton Creek.

DRAINAGE AREA.--96.7 mi².

SURFACE-WATER RECORDS

PERIOD OF RECORD.--Continuous discharge gage, October 1965 to September 1994, recording crest stage gage October 1994 to Sept. 30, 2007.

GAGE.--Water stage recorder. Datum of gage is 906.8 ft above sea level.

REMARKS.--Water-quality data collected at this site 1966 to 1977. U.S. Army Corps of Engineers satellite telemeter at station.

EXTREMES FOR PERIOD OF RECORD.--Maximum discharge, 3,030 ft³/s, Sept.9, 2004, gage height, 12.57 ft.
