

**04044813 Two Hearted River near Paradise, MI**

Southeastern Lake Superior Basin  
Betsy-Chocolay Subbasin

LOCATION.--Lat 46°41'15", long 85°26'26" referenced to North American Datum of 1927, in SE ¼ NW ¼ sec.33, T.50 N., R.9 W., Luce County, MI, Hydrologic Unit 04020201, on right bank 300 ft downstream from end of two-track road, 3.2 mi upstream from mouth, and 20 mi northwest of Paradise.

DRAINAGE AREA.--200 mi<sup>2</sup>.

**SURFACE-WATER RECORDS**

PERIOD OF RECORD.--Water year 1972 (operated as a low-flow partial-record station), 1973-75 (operated as a low-flow and crest-stage partial-record station), 1976 to current year.

GAGE.--Crest-stage gage. Prior to May 17, 1988, at site 3 mi downstream at different datum.

EXTREMES FOR PERIOD OF RECORD.--Maximum discharge, 3,350 ft<sup>3</sup>/s, Apr. 19, 2002, gage height, 14.53 ft.
