LOCATION.--Lat 41°04'51", long 77°32'59" referenced to North American Datum of 1927, Clinton County, PA, Hydrologic Unit 02050204, on right bank at abandoned railroad bridge, 1.5 mi downstream from Beech Creek, and 4.2 mi downstream from Foster Joseph Sayers Dam.

DRAINAGE AREA.--562 mi².

SURFACE-WATER RECORDS

PERIOD OF RECORD.--1910-95 (continuous-record gaging station), 1996 to current year.

GAGE.--Water-stage recorder and crest-stage gage. Datum of gage is 560.00 ft above National Geodetic Datum of 1929. Satellite and landline telemetry at station.

COOPERATION.--Station established and maintained by the U.S. Geological Survey in cooperation with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Baltimore District.

EXTREMES FOR PERIOD OF RECORD.--Discharge, 25,600 ft³/s, gage height, 14.42 ft (site and datum in use before Oct 1984), Mar 18, 1936.
