LOCATION.--Lat 39°50'31", long 82°59'00" referenced to North American Datum of 1927, Franklin County, OH, Hydrologic Unit 05060001.

**GROUND-WATER RECORDS**

WELL CHARACTERISTICS.--Depth 195 ft. Upper casing diameter 4.0 in; top of first opening 185 ft, bottom of last opening 195 ft. Observation well.

DATUM.--Land-surface datum is 706.75 ft above North American Vertical Datum of 1988. Measuring point: Top of pvc casing, 2.90 ft above land-surface datum, July 1, 2002, to present.

PERIOD OF RECORD.--Periodic water-level measurements from Sept. 18, 1995 to current year.

COOPERATION.--Ground-water-level data are collected as part of a USGS cooperative study with the City of Columbus.

REMARKS.--This well is part of a long-term ground-water monitoring network in southern Franklin County.

EXTREMES FOR PERIOD OF RECORD.--Highest water level measured, 39.93 ft below land-surface datum, Aug. 25, 2005; lowest measured, 135.40 ft below land-surface datum, March 13, 1996.
