WELL CHARACTERISTICS.--Depth 106.6 ft. Upper casing diameter undefined; top of first opening 104.6 ft, bottom of last opening 106.6 ft. Bored, unused water-table well.

DATUM.--Land-surface datum is 541 ft above National Geodetic Vertical Datum of 1929. Measuring point: top of casing, 2.6 ft above land-surface datum, June 14, 1988, to present.

PERIOD OF RECORD.--June 1988, to August 1989, May 1995 to current year.
