

01543700 FIRST FORK SINNEMAHONING CREEK AT WHARTON, PA

West Branch Susquehanna Basin
Sinnemahoning Subbasin

LOCATION.--Lat 41°31'08", long 78°01'40" referenced to North American Datum of 1927, Potter County, PA, Hydrologic Unit 02050202, at bridge on State Highway 872, 0.8 mi southwest of Wharton, and 1 mi downstream of East Fork Sinnemahoning Creek.

DRAINAGE AREA.--182 mi².

SURFACE-WATER RECORDS

PERIOD OF RECORD.--1968-80, 1982 (low-flow partial-record station), 1984 to current year.

GAGE.--Water-stage recorder and crest-stage gage. Datum of gage is 1,062.68 ft above National Geodetic Vertical Datum of 1929. Satellite telemetry at station.

COOPERATION.--Station established and maintained by the U.S. Geological Survey in cooperation with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Baltimore District, and the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection.
