LOCATION.--Lat 40°20'45", long 78°52'58" referenced to North American Datum of 1927, Cambria County, PA, Hydrologic Unit 05010007, upstream from bridge on State Highway 271 at East Conemaugh, 300 ft downstream from Clapboard Run, and 2.7 mi upstream from confluence with Stonycreek River.

DRAINAGE AREA.--183 mi².

SURFACE-WATER RECORDS

PERIOD OF RECORD.--1939-95 (continuous-record), 1996 to current year (peak discharge).

GAGE.--Water-stage recorder and crest-stage gage. Datum of gage is 1,211.29 ft above National Geodetic Vertical Datum of 1929. Satellite telemetry at station.

COOPERATION.--Station established and maintained by the U.S. Geological Survey in cooperation with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Pittsburgh District.
