West Branch Susquehanna Basin

LOCATION.--Lat 41°31'08", long 78°01'40" referenced to North American Datum of 1927, Potter County, PA, Hydrologic Unit 02050202, at bridge on State Highway 872, 0.8 mi southwest of Wharton, and 1 mi downstream of East Fork Sinnemahoning Creek.

DRAINAGE AREA.--182 mi<sup>2</sup>.

**SURFACE-WATER RECORDS**

PERIOD OF RECORD.--1968-80, 1982 (low-flow partial-record station), 1984 to current year.

GAGE.--Water-stage recorder and crest-stage gage. Datum of gage is 1,062.68 ft above National Geodetic Vertical Datum of 1929. Satellite telemetry at station.

COOPERATION.-- Station established and maintained by the U.S. Geological Survey. Funding for the operation of this station is provided by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Baltimore District, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection, and the U.S. Geological Survey through the Cooperative Water Program.
