LOCATION.--Lat 37°52'36", long 79°58'39" referenced to North American Datum of 1927, Alleghany County, VA, Hydrologic Unit 02080201, on right bank 20 ft upstream from Smith Bridge, 0.8 mi south of Falling Spring, and 5.5 mi north of Covington.

DRAINAGE AREA.--410 mi².

SURFACE-WATER RECORDS

PERIOD OF RECORD.--1925 to 1984 (operated as a continuous-record station), 1987 to current year.

GAGE.--Crest-stage gage. Datum of gage is 1,333.49 ft NGVD of 1929.

EXTREMES FOR PERIOD OF RECORD.--Maximum discharge, 24,700 ft³/s, March 17, 1936, gage height, 14.74 ft.
