

03263168 Stillwater River near Ansonia Ohio

Great Miami Basin
Upper Great Miami Subbasin

LOCATION.--Lat 40°13'01", long 84°36'44" referenced to North American Datum of 1927, Darke County, OH, Hydrologic Unit 05080001, on State Route 47, 1.2 mi east of Ansonia, 0.2 mi. east of Beisner Rd., and 1.8 mi west of Dawn (Dawn 1:24000 quad).

DRAINAGE AREA.--74.3 mi².

SURFACE-WATER RECORDS

PERIOD OF RECORD.--Established initially as low flow site December 1994 through to current year at Beisner Road, about .25 mile upstream. Established as a crest-stage gage site from Oct. 2001, through to current year at SR 47.

REVISED RECORDS.--WDR OH-06: 2002-05 (P). WDR OH-10: 2002, 2006, 2008 (P).

GAGE.--Crest-stage gages: 3 gages located on right bank at approach section, 180 ft. upstream of bridge; 2 gages on right bank 1 ft. upstream of bridge; 2 gages located on right bank at tailwater section, 90 ft. downstream of bridge.

REMARKS.--This is a partial-record station, a station at which limited streamflow data are collected on a systematic basis over a period of years for use in hydrologic analyses. Data collected at this partial-record station are used in both low-flow and peak-flow analyses.

EXTREMES FOR PERIOD OF RECORD.--Maximum discharge, 3,990 cfs, Mar. 6, 2011; gage height, 97.54 ft.
