LOCATION.--Lat 34°10'48", long 88°18'47" referenced to North American Datum of 1927, Itawamba County, MS, Hydrologic Unit 03160101, Chickasaw Meridian, on downstream side of main channel at left abutment, on county highway 2 mi east of Tilden, 3 mi downstream from Gum Creek, 14 mi upstream from mouth.

DRAINAGE AREA.--274.0 mi².

SURFACE-WATER RECORDS

PERIOD OF RECORD.--2001 to current year; 1992 to 1997, operated as a flood-hydrograph station.

GAGE.--Crest-stage gage. Datum of gage is assumed at 290 ft.

EXTREMES FOR PERIOD OF RECORD.--Maximum discharge, 26,900 ft³/s, Dec. 7, 2004, maximum gage height, 22.24 ft, Dec. 7, 2004.

EXTREMES FOR CURRENT YEAR.--Maximum discharge, 4,560 ft³/s, Jan. 17, 2013, gage height, 18.68 ft.
