LOCATION.--Lat 32°28'03", long 89°47'55" referenced to North American Datum of 1983, in NE ¼ NE ¼ sec.8, T.7 N., R.5 E., Rankin County, MS, Hydrologic Unit 03180002, Choctaw Meridian, at 54 inch circular culvert on Old Highway 43, 4 miles east of Pisgah, or 1 mile east of Highway 43, and 1 and a half miles north of Highway 481.

DRAINAGE AREA.--0.10 mi<sup>2</sup>.

**SURFACE-WATER RECORDS**

PERIOD OF RECORD.--1965 to current year.

GAGE.--Crest-stage gage. Datum of gage is assumed at 340 ft.

EXTREMES FOR PERIOD OF RECORD.--Maximum discharge, 158 ft<sup>3</sup>/s, Apr. 11, 2005, maximum gage height, 7.95 ft, Apr. 11, 2005.

EXTREMES FOR CURRENT YEAR.--Maximum discharge, 72 ft<sup>3</sup>/s, March 10, 2013, gage height, 5.43 ft.
