07050390 OSAGE CREEK SOUTHWEST OF BERRYVILLE, AR

Upper White Basin
Beaver Reservoir Subbasin

LOCATION.--Lat 36°20'55", long 93°35'28" referenced to North American Datum of 1983, in SW ¼ sec.36, T.20 N., R.25 W., Carroll County, AR, Hydrologic Unit 11010001, at bridge on State Hwy 221 at McKennon Ford, and 1.0 mi southwest of Berryville.

SURFACE-WATER RECORDS

PERIOD OF RECORD.--Oct 1987 to Sep 1990 operated as a low-flow partial-record station. Oct 1996 to current year operated as miscellaneous site.

REMARKS.--As the number of streams on which streamflow information is likely to be desired far exceeds the number of continuous-record stream-gaging stations feasible to operate at one time, the USGS collects limited streamflow data at sites other than the continuous-record stream-gaging stations. When discharge measurements are made at sites not included in the continuous-record or partial-record program, these measurements, generally made in times of drought or flood to give better areal coverage to those events, and others collected for some special reason are called measurements at miscellaneous sites. Discharge measurements in the following table were made at this special study or miscellaneous site during the 2013 water year.
