LOCATION.--Lat 32°57'15", long 89°53'32" referenced to North American Datum of 1927, in SW ¼ sec.21, T.13 N., R.4 E., Holmes County, MS, Hydrologic Unit 08060201, Choctaw Meridian, at bridge on State Highway 14, 1.6 mi east of intersection with U.S. Highway 51 in Goodman.

DRAINAGE AREA.--1,338 mi<sup>2</sup>.

**SURFACE-WATER RECORDS**

PERIOD OF RECORD.--2004 to current year; 2001 to 2003, operated as a continuous-record gaging station.

GAGE.--Crest-stage gage. Datum of gage is 208.45 ft above NGVD of 1929.

EXTREMES FOR PERIOD OF RECORD.--Maximum discharge, 26,900 ft<sup>3</sup>/s, Dec. 17, 2001, maximum gage height, 23.67 ft, Dec. 17, 2001.

EXTREMES FOR CURRENT YEAR.--Maximum discharge, 13,100 ft<sup>3</sup>/s, Jan. 20, 2013, gage height, 22.01 ft.
